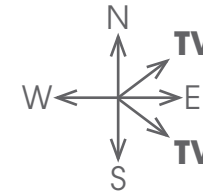

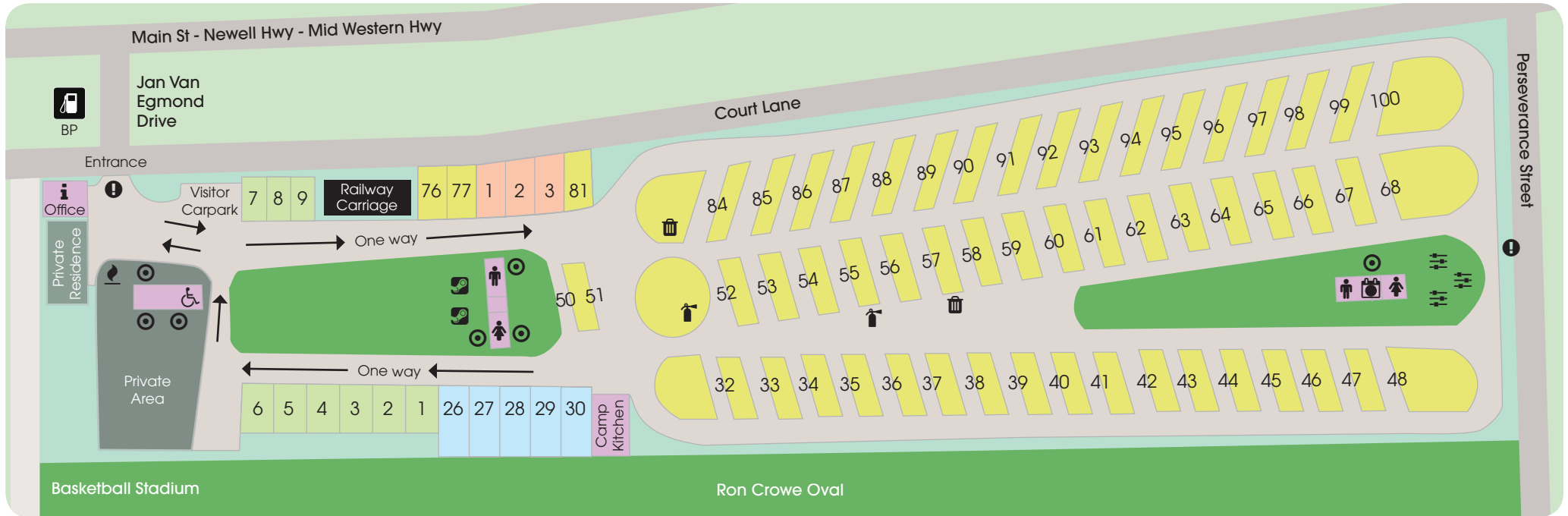

# Rules

The following information and guidelines are provided to ensure park patrons (including their guests, visitors and invitees) to our park have an enjoyable stay.

## 1. Payment

Accommodation balance must be paid no later than the arrival date.

## 2. Check In/Out

Cabin accommodation-check in from 2pm, check out 10am.  
Camping and caravan sites-check in from 11am, check out 10am.  
Late checkouts can be arranged subject to availability. Fee applies.

## 3. Occupational Health and Safety (OHS)

Park patrons must comply with any directions of the Park management in relation to Occupational Health and Safety.

## 4. Courteous and Considerate Manner

Park patrons should act in a courteous and considerate manner towards the Park Owner, Park Managers, and their respective employees or contractors and other occupants and guests of the park.

## 5. Vehicles

Please ask your visitors to park their vehicles in the visitor car park. No vehicle is to be parked on roadways or other patrons site within the park.  
**Please do not wash vehicles or vans on-site.**

## 6. Speed Limit

The safety of our customers is of prime importance. You can assist our cause by limiting the speed of your vehicle to 10 kilometers (walking pace) whilst within the Park.

## 7. Pets

Mild mannered dogs are welcome ONLY for guests staying on camping and caravan sites. Unfortunately, pets are strictly not permitted in cabin accommodation. Your dog must be kept on a leash and you are responsible for them at all times. Dogs are not permitted in amenities, camp kitchens and recreational facilities. Owners please clean up after your dog.

## 8. Children

The park and its facilities are provided for the enjoyment of you and your children. The supervision of your children is important for their safety and so they are not a nuisance or danger to themselves or others. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the showers, toilets and recreational facilities.

## 9. Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Skates and Roller Blades

Park patrons are responsible for their children at all times. Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards, and Roller Skates/Blades must be ridden with extreme care.

- No riding around amenity blocks, laundries, office, camp kitchens or barbecue areas at any time.
- Speed limit and other road signs must be obeyed at all times.
- As required by law bike helmets must be worn.
- No riding after street lights are on at night.

The Management cannot accept responsibility for any injuries occurred through accidents whilst in the park.

## 10. Your Site

Please keep your site clean and tidy at all times and use the facilities provided for drying clothes, discharge of sullage water and rubbish disposal. Please do not dig trenches on or around your site. Unfortunately open fires are strictly prohibited and no fire crackers are permitted under law.

## 11. Noise

The peaceful enjoyment of our park and its facilities by all visitors is important to us. Please assist by being considerate to your neighbors and restrict noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings after 10pm at night and before 6am.

## 12. Problems/Concerns

Please notify Park Management of concerns at the time of the problem, they will endeavor to rectify the situation; therefore ensuring your stay is a positive one.

## 13. Securing your Site

While Park Management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, it is recommended that visitors take the precautions of securing items of value left outside their tent, caravan or cabin during the day and overnight.

## 14. Other Facilities and Amenities

Rules for Use and Time of Use, as posted on or near other facilities and amenities, must be observed.

## 15. Smoking

In accordance with the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000, smoking is not permitted:

- Within 10 meters of children's play equipment;
- Within 4 meters of a pedestrian access point to a building; and
- In any other area or building within the park where no-smoking signs are displayed.

## 16. General Rules and Information

- Please beware of falling trees.
- Sites are between power poles. There is one power outlet and one tap per site. Water is drinkable.
- All sites are 15 amp - if power goes out you will need to see management to reset fuse.
- Sullage water must be either piped to gully or bucket used for collection and put on trees.
- All vehicles and goods must be kept within your allotted site.
- Please empty milk containers and wrap garbage before placing in bin.
- Food scraps, cigarette butts, bottle tops and tea bags must be put in bin.
- Camp kitchen is available to all, however children 14 years and under must be supervised whilst in kitchen. Please do not use kitchen between 9:30pm and 6am.
- Free BBQ's - Please turn off light and clean plate after use.

Park Management has the right to direct any park patron (Including their guests, including visitors and invitees) to leave the park if that person refuses to comply with the park rules, causes and nuisance, or interferes with the use and enjoyment of the park.
